LOCATION OF COMPETITION VENUE

The Competition Venue is situated at the <u>Old Woodcraft Pavilion</u>, which is between the Entrance Gates and the Show Ring within the Redcliffe Showgrounds. The Entrance Gates are off Scarborough Road, Redcliffe, behind the Redcliffe Hospital and just North of the intersection with Portwood Street.

WOODCRAFT COMPETITION - PEOPLE'S CHOICE

The general public visiting the Woodcraft Pavilion this year, will be invited to select three entries from the competition display, which in their opinion are worthy prizewinners. The People's Choice votes will be aggregated with prizes awarded to the highest ranking entries.

Receive Entries - from 1.00pm to 4.00pm on Sunday 25th June 2023, at Old Woodcraft Pavilion. Redcliffe Showgrounds, Competition Entries close - 4.00pm on Sunday 25th June 2023. Entry Collection time – from 3:30pm on Sunday 2nd July 2023 at Old Woodcraft Pavilion Redcliffe Showgrounds.

COMPETITION DIRECTION

WOODCRAFT TECHNIQUES IN A STATE OF CHANGE.

The Club recognizes emerging changes in Woodcraft Techniques and the Woodcraft Competition needs to keep pace with these changes and cater for traditional forms of woodcraft.

With the advent of computerisation in woodcraft, the RDWS competition will, until further reviewed, cater for **Traditional Woodcraft** techniques where the actual construction of the article is in the main completed by hand. By entering items in designated category/class, members agree that the entry complies with the spirit of the aforementioned condition and thatno part of the work has been completed with the assistance of computerization. (Excludes standard hardware items.)

For the purpose of clarification, Traditional Woodcraft Techniques have been determined as items where a major part of the work has been completed by hand. Use of jigs, such as lathe indexing jigs, deep hollowing tools, dovetail jigs, hinge positioning jigs are permitted. This list is not exhaustive but illustrates that all must be controlled by hand to achieve the end result.

Traditional woodwork will relate closely to the Category description. If an item is in the main aturned article, then it must be entered in Turning. It follows that, entries in all other classes where the majority of the work aligns directly with a particular category then that entry cannotbe entered in a class other than those tied directly to that category. The chief steward has theright to remove an item from a class where this condition is not met and enter the item in a more appropriate class.

- 1. A Competition Entry is entered at the risk of the Competitor who is responsible for arranging any insurance.
- 2. <u>Competition Fee \$2.00 per Entry</u> (Entry Fee \$1.00 and Administration Fee \$1.00) must accompany the correctly completed Competition Entry Form.
- 3. Stewards will be in attendance at the Old Woodcraft Pavilion. Redcliffe Showgrounds to receive Competition Entries and Competition Entry Forms. All Competition Entries and Competition Entry Forms must be in the hands of the Stewards by Entry Closing time. The Chief Steward has the discretion to review and alter in consultation with the entrant, the skill level recorded for the entrant.

- 4. A Competition Entry must not have been entered in any previous Woodcraft Competition conducted by the Redcliffe and District Woodcraft Society Inc. A Competitor islimited to not more than two (2) Entries in any Class. A Competition Entry in a particular Class is ineligible to be entered in any other Class.
- 5. A Competition Entry must be original, unaided work, created solely and totally by the Competitor and completed within two years prior to the closing date. A Competition Entry is considered **NOT** to be the unaided work of the Competitor if another person has performed **ANY** of the work comprising the completed Competition Entry.
- 6. <u>In relation to Class 8 Article Featuring Pyrographic Technique</u>, the pyrography must be on wood and not on any other medium.
- Competition Entries may be collected from the Old Woodcraft Pavilion from 3.30pm on Sunday 2nd July. Return freight or postage must be forwarded with any Competition Entry which is to be returned to the Competitor other than by collection from the Woodcraft Society - See Item 8.
- Any Competition Entry not collected <u>prior to 2.00pm on Tuesday 11th July 2023</u> (where arrangements have not been made concerning the collection or return of the Competition Entry) will become the property of the Redcliffe and District Woodcraft Society and may be disposed of as the Management Committee of the Redcliffe and District Woodcraft Societydirects.
- 9. All decisions of the Convenors of the Woodcraft Competition are **FINAL** and are not subject to review.
- 10. A Competition Entry must have the Competitor's name hidden from the sight of the Judges.
- 11. A simple majority of the Competition Chief Steward and Stewards then available
 - a. may declare "no-competition" in any Class in which there are less thanthree (3) Competition Entries; and
 - b. may refuse to accept any Entry, or may disqualify any Entry already accepted which, in their opinion, does not conform with the Rules and By-Laws of the Redcliffe AH&I Society Inc, or does not conform with these Competition Conditions, or does not fall into any of the Classes of the Competition; and
 - c. may reallocate an entry into a Class other than the Class nominated by the Competitor. Once reallocated, an Entry will be regarded in all respectsas being entered in that Class; and
 - d. without unreasonable delay in the particular circumstances, may determine any other matter which reasonably results from the conduct of the Competition but not specifically referred to in these Conditions.
 - e. and any such decisions are Final and are not subject to review.
- 12. A Competition Entry may be photographed for the purposes of the Redcliffe and District Woodcraft Society, including publication.
