REGULATIONS FOR BEEF CATTLE

- Under the current Queensland Government Mandate every person over 16 years of age attending the Redcliffe Show will need to be double vaccinated and must provide evidence of vaccination status to enter the Redcliffe Show Grounds.
- All exhibitors should refer to the [General Competition Regulations](#) as provided by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Society's Inc and applicable Society/Association.
- All entries must be from accredited disease free herds.
- All cattle must be tick free. It is the responsibility of the owner or person in charge of the stock to contact their nearest Department of Agriculture and Fisheries biosecurity inspector and arrange for treatment (where necessary) of their stock according to statutory requirements.
- All exhibitors to have public liability insurance and to have same endorsed for travelling to shows.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings and parades are capable of exercising control over animals in their care. Children under 12 years of age leading cattle in the Grand Parade to be accompanied by an adult.
- Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the judging ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of the public.
- All cattle travelling to the show must have an NLIS device applied before leaving property of origin (includes calves).
- On arrival all exhibitors must supply to the chief steward NLIS number for all animals (the visual number on the NLIS tag) the PIC of the property the animals are last registered to and supply move waybill or NVD/waybill number.
- All bulls over four months must have a nose grips and 12 months must have a nose ring.
