ENTRY INFORMATION

Schools are invited to enter samples of student work. This can be in *Best School Display* (in a booth) or as Student Work. Private entries are encouraged from home. There are no entry fees. *Note: Please provide a list of entries (runner) from your school

Please note that 'CLASS' is the Show's number for the category entered into and not a student's school class/year level

All entries are to be labelled - See proforma labels to be applied to back of work at rear of this booklet.

Students' work—(includes Home Schooled Students)

- 1. All entries must be placed correctly on tables for judging according to their **CLASS** number under subject headings.
- 2. Work must be done in *school and be the sole/original work of the student whose name appears on the back of the entry. *under School Conditions for Home Schooled Students
- 3. Each teacher can pre-select a maximum of 3 pieces of work from each classroom in each class section. Each entry must have the following information on the back: CLASS, Subject, Year Level (Kindergarten and Special Schools only by age), Student Name & School As per the label in back of this schedule.

Private Entries from Home are detailed in a separate section

- 1. All entries must be placed correctly on tables for judging according to their **CLASS** number.
- 2. Work must be done at home and be the sole/original work of the student whose name appears on the back of the entry.
- 3. Each entry must have the following information on the back: CLASS, Subject, Year Level, Student Name, Private Entry, Parent/Caregiver's name & mobile number As per the label in back of this schedule.

Story Writing/Short Story: Original story, not a re-tell or procedure. No illustrations. Prep/Y1 may be 1-3 sentences (or more) handwritten; Y3-6 may be computer copy. 1 Page x Max A4. *For computer copy - use 12pt font (Chalkboard or Comic Sans.)

Poetry: Original work. Handwritten or computer copy. 1 Page x Max A4.

Drawing: Any drawing medium; not computer generated or traced. Max A4.

Painting or Printing: Any medium or genre. Max A4.

Craft item: includes collage.

Project - Individual: book, project board. Max A3.

Project - Pairs: book, project board. Max A3.

3D: e.g. pottery, construction, sculpture, model, lego construction - NB Must be own creation - no commercial / off the shelf sets.

Photography: Scenery/Still Life or People/Animals. Max A4.
