**GATE FEES APPLY TO ALL COMPETITORS - STRICTLY NO TICKET, NO ENTRY**

Special Note: **All live stock must enter through the gate beside Redcliffe Hockey Club, Lamington Drive, Redcliffe.**

## GENERAL RULES

- All horses must be in Show condition to the satisfaction of the Stewards.
- All entries will be under the Rules and Regulations of the Equestrian Australia Jumping.
- The Judge may withhold any award if the entry does not merit a prize.
- Nominations must be paid before competitors are allowed to compete.
- Entry tickets must be presented to Stewards at the start of the event.
- Competitors must carry their Competitor's Card in ALL Ring events.

**ALL PARTICIPATING ENTRANTS MUST COMPLETE THE:**

- QUEENSLAND AGRICULTURAL SHOWS HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION
- PARTICIPANT WAIVER, RELEASE & ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

## SOCIETY'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- All competitors compete at their own risk.
- The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any exhibitor at the Show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each competitor shall hold the Association harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceeding arising from the accident.
- The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, damage or mis-delivery of livestock or other exhibits at the Society's Show.
- There is no vet located on the Showgrounds, however, a vet can be called in an emergency.
- Any prize not claimed during the Show will be forfeited to the Society.
- Exhibitors and persons admitted to the grounds shall be subject to the Rules, Regulations and Orders of the Stewards and are required to pay normal admission prices unless exempted by the Association.
- The foregoing Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the notes as set forth in the Schedule are the conditions of competition. Any matter arising not specifically provided for in the foregoing shall be determined by the Committee, whose decision will be final.
- Floats must park in an orderly manner as directed by the Ground Steward.
- All person exhibiting must accept the decision of the Judges appointed by the Committee will be final and without appeal.
- Any person or persons interfering with the judge or who shall be guilty of unseemly conduct to a judge, steward or official of the show society or any exhibitors refusing in any way to carry out the instructions of a steward, shall be liable at the discretion of the committee to a penalty not exceeding \$50.00. Or otherwise may be disqualified from the exhibition for any period or may be expelled from the ground.
- If possible any prize money won on any day should be collected on the same day from the pay out section at the Nominations Building.
- **ANY EVENT WITH LESS THAN EIGHT (8) COMPETITORS; NO FIFTH PRIZE MONEY OR LOWER WILL BE PAID.**
- All competitors MUST assemble in the Marshalling Yard before entering.
- All jumping events are formal. Exhibitors MUST wear a COAT.
- PLEASE NOTE: Classes over 105cm height must be members with Equestrian Queensland.
- The Redcliffe Show Society reserves the right to change the Program at any time.

## SHOW SOCIETY RULES

- All competitors are subject to random drug testing at any time.
- Any event with total prize money of \$2,000.00 plus will be subject to compulsory drug tests.
- Please note: - All competitors are responsible for care and security of their horses whilst on the show grounds at all times.
- **RIDERS MUST BE MOUNTED TO CLAIM PRIZE MONEY AND RIBBONS.**

## JUNIOR AND YOUNG RIDERS

Junior and young riders may start in both junior and senior classes at this show on the same horse.

**SAFETY HEADGEAR:** As you will no doubt recall, as from 1 January 1991, all Show jumping competitors will be required to wear a Safety Helmet that complies with Australian Standard 2063.3. This also applies to competitors and others in the 'warm up' area.

The Safety Helmet that complies with AS2063.3 will have a sticker on the external of the hat, and a tab on the inside with the above-mentioned number.

**Helmet Tagging** was made mandatory for all EA Jumping events from 1 January 2022.

Remember, ensuring that your helmet is compliant and safe is always the responsibility of the athlete and a compliant helmet is mandatory under the EA National Jumping Rules and EA General Regulations.

Helmet tagging only indicates that the helmet complies with current EA standards.
